



## Scrutineering Checklist

There are no facilities to purchase any parts or clothing at Willare for the 2014 event, please ensure your bike will pass scrutineering as per the 2014 Manual of Motorcycling Sport. If your bike fails scrutineering it must be re-presented to Chief Scrutineer before 7:00am Saturday morning.

- Throttle return
- Bar ends
- Brake and clutch leavers to be ball ended
- Brake and clutch effectiveness
- Nerf bars (quads)
- Dead man switch on quads (will be tested)
- Fluid leaks
- Hose clamps-fuel line
- Engine mount bolts
- Muffler secure- noise testing will be taking place as directed by COC
- Foot peg condition and return
- Wheel frame and bearing free play
- Axle and nuts
- Spokes
- Chain and chain guards
- Sharp edges removed including steel number plates
- Correct numbers easily visible, quads to have number on front and rear, 2 wheelers on front number plate and both sides
- Correct protective clothing (boots, pants, jersey, gloves, goggles & helmet (Australian Standard) must be presented to scrutineer

Ambulance cover must be sighted by sign on officials

Private health cover is accepted when proof of ambulance cover is included

QLD drivers licence holders are covered on presentation of current licence

**It is a long track and we recommend that you carry at least a 2 litre camel pack full of water**
